

Gold Standard Fabric Checklist rev. January 2022



Gold Standard Fabric Content: (no bed sheets or used fabric)

Drawstring Bags: quality, durable, 100% cotton or cotton/poly blend Liners: quality, 100% cotton, double-brushed flannel (flannelette) Shields: quality, durable, 100% cotton (quilter's cotton); 1 (or 2) mil PUL or other DfGI approved moisture barrier Carry Pouches: 1 or 2 mil PUL or other DfGI approved moisture barrier; optional woven layer 100% cotton or cotton/poly blend

Fabric Prints: choose fun, attractive, vibrant prints and colors whenever possible

Gold Standard - Best

Stain-hiding: bright, colorful, busy **Culturally neutral, globally accepted**:

- botanicals (including fruits and vegetables), geometrics, batiks
- butterflies & ladybugs (no faces or eyes)
- uplifting words (love, friendship, beautiful, etc.)

Able to pass the "yard test" and the "gift test:" Is the fabric stain-hiding enough to hang in your front yard? Would you proudly give it as a gift?

Selective Usage

Less stain-hiding fabrics: limit use to the backs of Shields, Drawstring Bags or optional woven layer for Carry Pouches Culturally specific images: (pop culture, holidays, celebrities): use best judgement Solid fabrics: pair with prints when possible

Area specific - Don't Use

Muslim populations:

- images, silhouettes or skulls of people, animals, fish or birds; butterflies and ladybugs are okay
- faces or eyes on inanimate objects (trains, clouds, etc.) **Thailand:**
 - depictions of food, dishes or eating implements

Not Fit for Purpose - Don't Use

Non-stain-hiding: extra light colors, bland, solid white, solid yellow

Camouflage: military or hunting, any color Weapons: including arrows that look like a weapon National icons: flags, landmarks, place names Religious or cultural symbols: cross, star of David, dreamcatcher, peace sign, solid yellow (sacred to Buddhists) Snakes or insects: butterflies and ladybugs are okay Offensive content: words or images that objectify women, makeup, glam
