General Information:

- Please arrive 10 15 minutes early to set up your work station.
- Please bring a task light if you feel you need it.
- Please bring a coffee mug.
- Bring your lunch and a snack. We provide tea and coffee.

Supply List

- 1 pack of Chacopy paper by Clover
- 1 blunt Clover wheel (i.e. not the pointy one). Debby can order at least one month in advance if needed, about \$10 (see image below).
- 1 pack embroidery needles suggest size 10
- 1 small scissor
- Masking tape
- Cutting mat 18 x 24 inches or rotating mat, similar size
- Rotary cutter
- Thread: DMC #8 Pearl Thread or Finca pearl thread #8. You could use embroidery floss but it tends to split and is difficult to work with.* If you have Sashiko thread bring it.
- Background fabric (well pressed) at least 20 inches square. It must be solid cotton, any colour, but insure that your thread contrasts well, e.g. Indigo blue fabric with white thread.
- Batting and backing are optional since they will not be used in the class.
- Beads to embellish are optional

*Re thread: The instructor can order the thread for you at \$3.69 per skein plus shipping. This must be done one month ahead of workshop. Go to Herrschners online to select the colour codes of thread that you wish to purchase.
